## ICRT Reiki Membership Association Standards of Practice

- **1.** Use ICRT manuals when teaching your classes. Supply one manual per student. Manuals must be purchased from www.reikiwebstore.com.
- 2. Professional members: supply the RMA certificates for your students.
- **3.** Professional members use the title of Professional member of the RMA or Professional member of the Reiki Membership Association in their advertising and literature. Affiliate members use the title of Affiliate member of the RMA or Affiliate member of the Reiki Membership Association in their advertising and literature.
- 4. Reply to all Reiki related e-mail and voice mail in a timely way.
- **5.** Use a client information form and session documentation form in your Reiki sessions (available on website under Resources and Downloads).
- 6. Create a safe, comfortable, harmonious space for your sessions and classes.
- 7. Training including Attunements, Placements and Ignitions may be given in person or online.
- 8. When teaching Reiki classes, use only the RMA Reiki symbols as drawn by Mrs. Takata for Reiki II, the Master Practitioner symbol and the Holy Fire® symbol for Reiki Master which are in the Reiki Master manual. No symbols are taught in Reiki I.
- **9.** Include time for lecture, discussion, demonstration, practice time and questions and answers in all your classes.
- 10. Reiki I & II can be taught together (Hayashi style) or separately according to teacher preference.
- **11.** In the Usui/Holy Fire<sup>®</sup> classes, ART and Master are now being taught together as one class called Reiki Master while in the Usui/Tibetan style, ART and Master are still taught separately or together as one class.
- **12.** Require that a student have practiced at the Reiki II level for a minimum of six months before taking ART or Reiki Master.
- **13.** Use the RMA class outlines. Additional topics can be taught at teacher's discretion.
- **14.** Minimum class times. The lower number is for small classes of 1-3 students and the longer time is for larger classes.

Reiki I – 5-8 hours Reiki II – 5-8 hours Usui/Tibetan ART – 5-8 hours Usui/Tibetan Master – 10-16 hours Usui/Tibetan Art/Master – 15-24 hours Usui/Holy Fire® Reiki Master – 15-24 hours
